

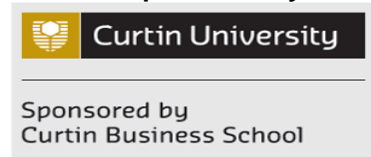
The International Conference on **Internet Technologies & Society 2013 (ITS 2013)** was held in Malaysia, from **29 November to 1 December, 2013**.

This conference was organized by the International Association for Development of the Information Society (IADIS) and co-organized by the Faculty of Computer Science & Information Technology, Universiti Putra Malaysia, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. The ITS 2013 conference intention was to cover both the technical as well the non-technical aspects of the main issues of concern within WWW/Internet as well as to assess the influence of Internet in the Information Society. The broad areas of interest were: Internet Technologies, Information Management, e-Society and Digital Divide, e-Business / e-Commerce, e-Learning, New Media and e-Society, Digital Services in e-Society, e-Government / e-Governance and e-Health.



The Internet Technologies & Society 2013 conference received 54 submissions from more than 16 countries. Each submission was reviewed in a double-blind review process by an average of four independent reviewers to ensure quality and maintain high standards. Out of the papers submitted, 8 got blind referee ratings that published them as full papers, which meant that the acceptance rate was 15%. Some other submissions were published as short papers, reflection paper and posters/demonstrations.
